Course Overview

Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who use well-developed skills and a broad knowledge base in a wide variety of contexts. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. They may provide leadership and guidance to others with some limited responsibility for the output of others.

There are 9 units of competency to complete for the full qualification.

A number of career pathways are available for workers completing the qualification, including OHS Manager and OHS Coordinator. After achieving this qualification candidates may undertake BSB51307 Diploma of Occupational Health and Safety.

Recommended For

This qualification would suit an OHS Officer in a full-time role who works under the supervision of an OHS Coordinator or OHS Manager.

Pre-Requisites

Pre-Requisites

There are no entry requirements for BSB41407 Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety, however the preferred pathways are:

BSB30707 Certificate III in Occupational Health and Safety or other relevant Certificate III qualification

OR

With extensive vocational experience in occupational health and safety roles.

Examples of indicative job roles for candidates seeking entry based on their vocational experience include:

- Health and Safety Representative
- Health and Safety Committee Member
- Health and Safety Assistant

This breadth of expertise would equate to the competencies required to undertake this qualification.

Due to the assessments for this course, participants are expected to have access to a workplace. This will provide participants with opportunities to practise and apply their skills and knowledge, and to complete practical assessment tasks.

A reasonable level of language, literacy and numeracy skills are required to comprehend OHS legislation and documentation, as well as the ability to communicate verbally and in written form.

Competencies



Competencies

There are 6 elective OHS units and 3 elective units which can be selected from a wide range of OHS and related units. A sample course structure would be as follows:

6.	BSBOHS408A	Assist with compliance with OHS and other relevant laws

Learning Arrangements

Assessment

To receive a Statement of Attainment for individual units you must successfully complete all the relevant assessment tasks. To obtain the qualification Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety (BSB41407) you must successfully complete all 9 units and accompanying assessments.

Skills Recognition

The process of Skills Recognition (Recognition of Prior Learning and/or Recognition of Current Competencies) gives those people with the relevant experience the opportunity to gain formal recognition for their competencies (skills and knowledge) gained through life, work and study, regardless of where, when and how they were achieved.

Participants are responsible for gathering evidence that will show they have the required competencies to the standard set out by the industry in the National Competency Standards.
